#### About the Instrument...

The organ is a three-manual Rodgers Artist 599. The instrument has 39 basic speaking stops, with an additional two selectable stops per division. The normal stoplist is in the American Classic-style. Each divisional stop has four stop choices available, which correlate to the four organ types: American Classic, French Romantic, German Baroque, and English Cathedral.
